

INFORMATION EQUIPMENT CONTROL



Fluor testing, randomly, after the race, close to the finish area.

Athletes must leave their skis in the drop off zone, upon demand.

Skis will be delivered back to the athletes in the pick up zone after testing.





NOTE! All skis must be marked with the date and bib number. This is the responsibility of the athlete.
